

HFA CORONAVIRUS MITIGATION STRATEGIES

DOORS, FACILITY, TRANSPORTATION

To minimize your need to touch door handles, our volunteer teams will hold exterior doors open to greet you. Volunteers and staff will sanitize door handles, stairway rails, classroom tables, and other high use areas. The church bus and van will also be sanitized after use.

CHILD CHECK-IN STATIONS

Volunteers will wipe down check-in surfaces regularly and between all services with disinfectant wipes. Hand sanitizer stations are available throughout our facility (lobby, fellowship hall, youth chapel).

GREETING

We recommend you greet each other with smiles, waves, and “elbow/fist bumps” instead of handshakes. If you prefer not to participate in greeting others during services, please feel free to remain seated.

OFFERING

We offer the option of giving your tithes and offerings online through our website. <https://www.hfachurch.org/> You may also download and give on our new Church Center App from the Apple App Store or Google Play. Search our area for First Assembly of God. Look for our HFA logo. The offering bags will still be passed during the services. As an additional option, you may choose to give in an offering bag held by an usher in the rear of the sanctuary.

KITCHEN

Ensure volunteer staff practice strict hygiene.

Wipe down all surfaces before and after food preparation.

Whenever possible serve food and use food service gloves.

Place utensils in the caddy with the handle up and the fork, spoon, or knife down.

PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY

We encourage you to commit to proper prevention measures to mitigate the virus spread for the safety of our higher risk elderly and those with underlying health conditions.

Please follow the CDC recommendations:

--Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

--Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.

--Stay home when you are sick.

--When coughing or sneezing, use a tissue to cover your mouth and nose and then throw the tissue in the trash. If you do not have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your arm.

--Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.

--Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.

--If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.

Always wash your hands with soap and water if your hands are visibly dirty.
